Well Wishes

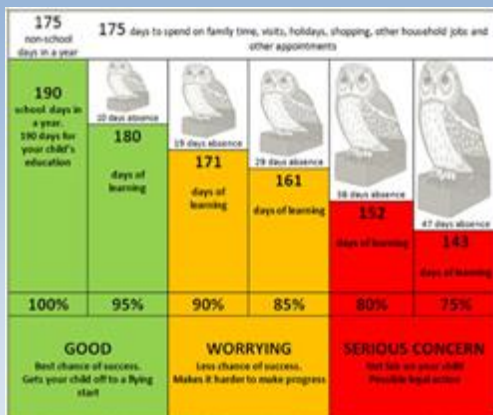
Sadly Father Alex is still in hospital recovering from his operation. Our thoughts and prayers are with him for a speedy recovery.
