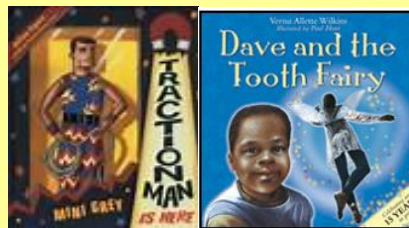
Ways to help your child at home:
