- Read and discuss together the "Wednesday Word" every week.

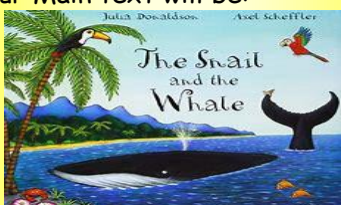
Learning Challenge:
