75% parents attending Place2Be 1-1 sessions with Parent Worker were parents/carers of pupils who were eligible for Pupil Premium Funding.

80% children supported by the Literacy Support Teacher were eligible for Pupil Premium Funding.

54% children working with Beanstalk volunteer readers were eligible for Pupil Premium Funding.
